Special broadcasting events, community outreach and educational activities for January, February, March 1998:

--CMS and the Minnesota Orchestra collaborated on a special outreach event, "At Home with the Minnesota Orchestra". Mark Sheldon and conductor Eiji Oue broadcast live from an extended-care facility on January 29. Over 200 such facilities around the state participated by listening to the special broadcast.
