By letter dated April 7, 2003, a copy of which is attached, Minnesota Public Radio, the licensee of KCRB- FM, informed the Commission that we were operating this station from a temporary facility.

MPR completed construction of KCRB (FM) on its new tower and is no longer operating the station from a temporary facility. In light of completion of construction in accordance with the pending Construction Permit, yesterday MPR filed an FCC form 302, application for FM Broadcast Station License, with the Commission (FCC File No BLED - 20030429AAO).

Because MPR is a noncommercial, educational licensee, no filing fee is required with this request. An Anti-Drug Abuse Act Certification form is attached.



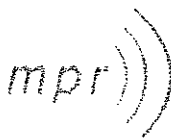

Dear Ms Dortch:

Minnesota Public Radio is the licensee of KCRB- FM and holds a Construction Permit (Permit File No BMPED-20011114ABQ) to move KCRB-FM to a new 1000 foot tower at a different site than its current location.

In accordance with 47 CFR 73.1615, the purpose of this letter is to inform the Commission that beginning sometime this week, while we are in the process of modifying our current facilities and moving to the new tower, Minnesota Public Radio will be operating KCRB-FM from a temporary facility. The temporary operations will be at a substantially lower power than our current license and the service area will not exceed the presently licensed coverage area for KCRB-FM.

Because MPR is a noncommercial, educational licensee, no filing fee is required with this request. An Anti-Drug Abuse Act Certification form is attached.
