Notice of Change in Primary Station Being Rebroadcast
FM Translator K297AD, Grand Rapids, Minnesota


Dear Ms Salas:

Minnesota Public Radio ("MPR"), the licensee of FM translator station K297AD, Grand Rapids, Minnesota (the "Station"), hereby notifies the Commission that the Station is now rebroadcasting the signal of WIRN(FM), Buhl, Minnesota, which is also licensed to MPR.

Until April 3, 1999, the Station rebroadcast the signal of MPR's WSCN(FM), Duluth, Minnesota. However, on April 3, 1999, WSCN went off the air due to damage sustained during a severe ice storm. MPR timely notified the Commission on April 13, 1999 that WSCN was off the air. While WSCN is presently operating from an emergency antenna pursuant to Section 73.1680 of the Commission's rules, K297AD will continue to rebroadcast WIRN until WSCN is able to resume normal broadcast operations. MPR will promptly notify the Commission when K297AD resumes rebroadcasting WSCN.
